

"Where refineries are typically limited by their geography or their proximity to crudes - we have access to global crude sources."

Ergon certainly has the infrastructure needed to work with this raw material. Its refinery in Vicksburg is the only naphthenic facility in the world with redundant hydroprocessing units in the same location. "Our operations allow us to produce high-quality, consistent products, with a scale that places us in a class of our own. 
